A drug is defined according to the Merriam-Webster dictionary as a pharmacological substance intended for use in the diagnosis, cure, mitigation, treatment or prevention of disease. 
Prescription drugs fall into several categories: antibiotics used in the treatment of various infections; analgesics otherwise known as pain relievers; sedatives used in treating insomnia and antihypertensives for

blood pressure lowering among others. More still, some pharmacologic agents are also classified as hard drugs. These are generally defined as substances with a high potential for abuse, severe addiction or death.

It is important to note that they may be legal or illegal depending on the circumstances surrounding their use. A few common examples include cocaine, heroin, marijuana (cannabis) and a host of others. Furthermore, drug abuse or misuse simply refers to the consumption of illegal drugs or the inappropriate use of legal or prescription drugs.


So here are a few tips that may help you find your perfect piece of Nigeria to call your home.

Camera

Gionee M6 Plus is packed with an amazing camera. The rear camera is 16MP with an LED flash and an Aperture size of 1.8 which has support for modes like HDR, touch focus, face/smile detection, etc. The front side is an 8MP camera with f/2.2 aperture ensuring incredible selfies.

Display

The display on this M6 Plus is a sharp IPS 1080 * 1920 Full HD resolution on a 6.0 inches screen size. Pixels on this phone is packed at a 367 pixel per inch which makes text, images and videos look sharp.

Memory

Storing musics, videos, pictures and files on the Gionee M6 won't be a problem as it packs a 64GB or 128GB internal memory which is expandable to up to 256GB with an external SD card. This means that it be will difficult to get the "Not enough space" notification, even if that happens, the space can always be expanded with an additional SD card. Also, 4GB of ram makes multi-tasking on this phone very easy, as many apps will be opened up at once

Battery

The battery on this device is very impressive. The Gionee M6 Plus comes with a non removable Li-Po 6020mAh battery that offers enough to power the phone.
